Restore Education is launching a \$4M sustainable growth campaign to support the purchase of the Learning Excellence Center, (D1) home base, and the expansion of services into San Antonio's Eastside, due to student-driven demand.

For 15 years, Restore Education has been dedicated to transforming lives of individuals, their families, and our community through education. We believe that education should be free, flexible, and available for all who are willing to work hard to achieve their dreams. We offer a continuum of services from basic literacy and English language learning to high school equivalency, career training, and college support.



Our vision for the new Eastside campus is to bring quality and value to a community that is used to receiving second-hand. We are restoring a building that was once office to State Rep. Barbara Gervin Hawkins -- a building that stood as a staple in the community. We are restoring this building to its original glory and ensuring it is something that Eastside residents will be proud to walk through and graduate from.

With a listening tour underway and continued community convening, Restore Education is prioritizing the needs of the community and voice of our students in shaping the curriculum that will be central to the Eastside campus. With endless opportunities to fill the workforce gaps of San Antonio, Restore Education has partnered with City of SA Ready to Work, United Way, Alamo Workforce Solutions, Alamo Colleges, and more. We are meeting with corporate partners on the Eastside and learning about their workforce gaps so that we can fill those needs with qualified Eastside residents and graduates of Restore Education.

We also recognize the many barriers to education. We hope that moving into the neighborhoods with the largest demand will also remove the barrier of transportation. In addition, we continue to partner with our 100+ community agencies to provide assistance with housing, food, mental health care, childcare, and workforce attire.

According to San Antonio's Equity Atlas, the Eastside neighborhood holds some of the most promise with vibrant culture and opportunity, yet it ranks as a "10" in services rendered for people of color in our community. Restore Education realizes the importance of the opportunity to disrupt generational inequities that have established the Eastside as the "underserved" neighborhood it is today.

Restore Education has proven its ability to meet student needs through wraparound support and collaboration with key local service providers like Workforce Solutions Alamo, Ready to Work, United Way, the Texas Workforce Commission, and so many more. By addressing gaps in traditional learning and providing a hybrid (virtual and in person) classroom setting, Restore Education has been able to successfully serve 17,000 students. That means 17,000 individuals are now making a living wage and working one job (as opposed to 3) -- changing the generational trajectory of what is possible and achievable.
